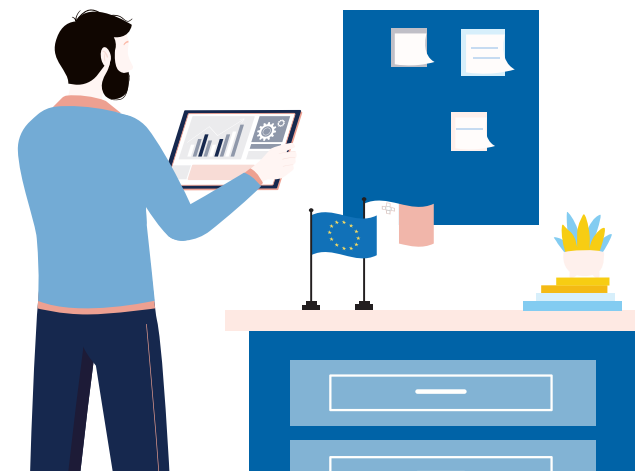

The first part is a plan on how to **create new opportunities** for adults who have a low level of education.



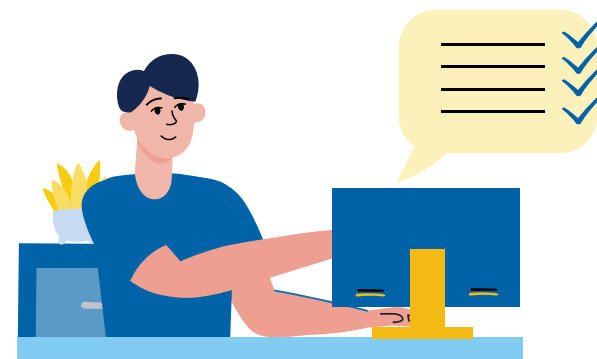
This plan has **three parts**.

The first part will **help these adults**.



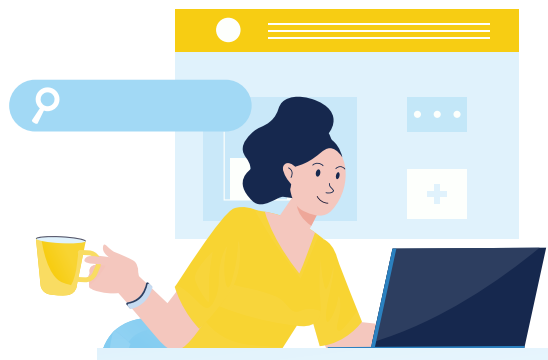
This will be done through a **list of suggestions** which will help adults learn more about their abilities.

One needs to give **different opportunities** to adults so that they can all learn.

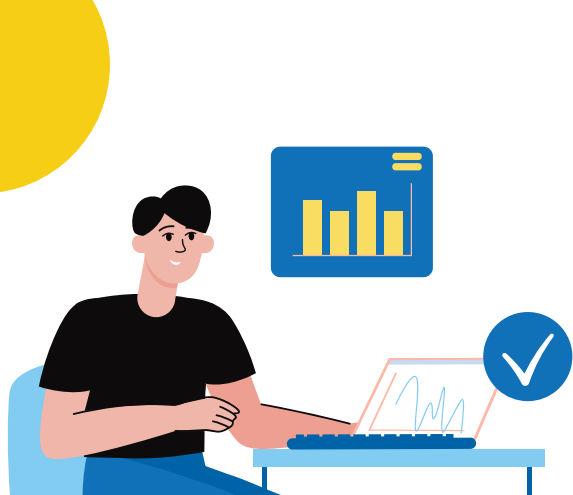


These courses will help the adults to **participate and integrate** within the community.
